

9. Vocabulary building using the SMART Thesaurus

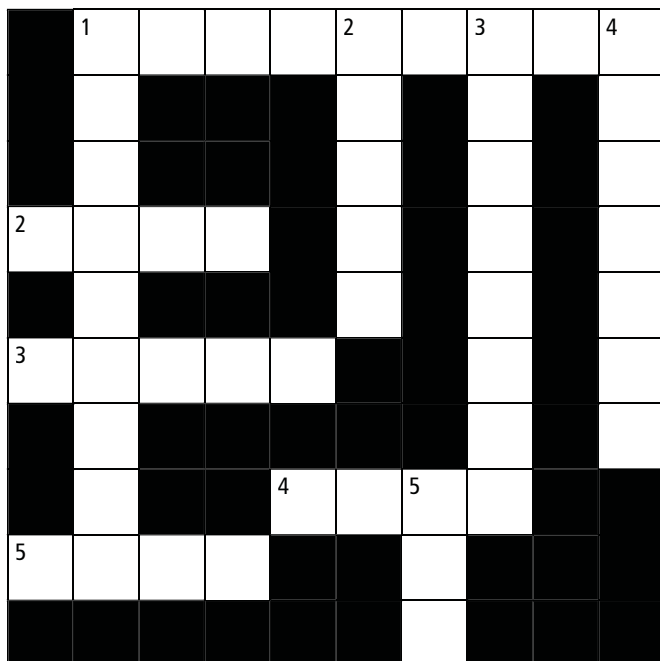

B. Use the SMART Thesaurus to complete the crossword. Look up the word in capitals and click on the SMART Thesaurus button to help you.

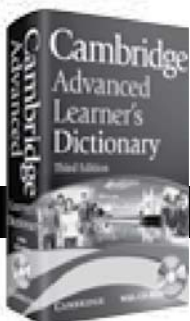


Across:
