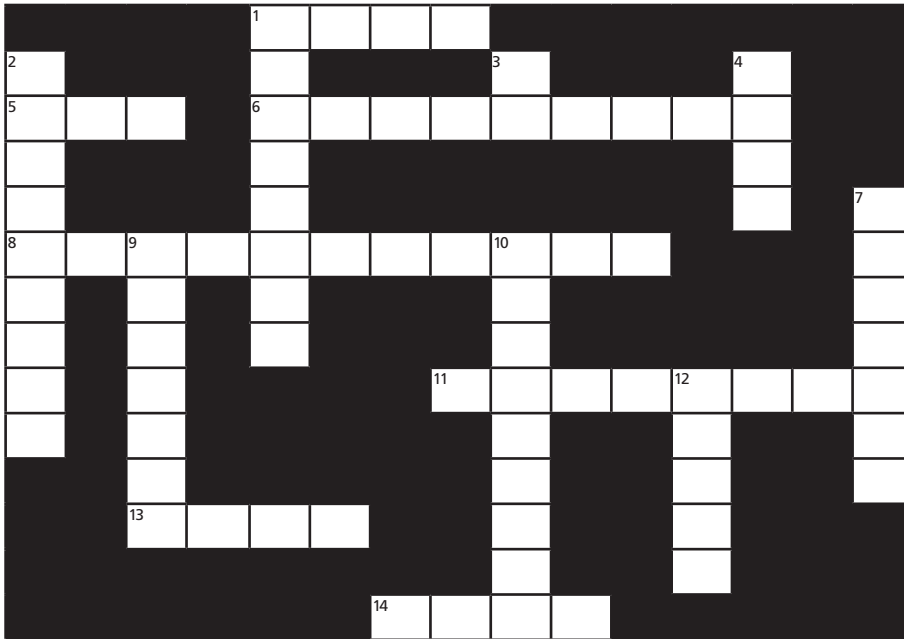


New words crossword – 1
