Slate

Wales is famous for slate. Slate is a flat, black rock. Slate is used to make roof tiles and floor tiles. Slate has been taken from the ground (quarried) in Wales since Roman times. Welsh quarries have produced more slate than any other slate quarries in the world



Coal
